Update on Flecainide Standardised Batch Sheet

The Health Quality & Safety Commission's Compounding Working Group has updated the batch sheet for compounded flecainide acetate suspension that is hosted on the PSNZ website.

The funded brand of flecainide tablets has changed from Tambocor to Flecainide BNM. Tambocor will be delisted from 1 February 2020.

A stability study commissioned by PHARMAC (unpublished) has confirmed stability of the existing formula when using either the Tambocor or Flecainide BNM brand. The only change to the batch sheet is the addition of a note to this effect.

The recommended storage condition remains '*at room temperature ($\leq 25^{\circ}\text{C}$)*' as there is a risk of precipitation if the preparation is stored in a refrigerator.
