Note: this formula uses Ora-Sweet SF®.

- 1. Pre-mix the Ora-Plus® and **Ora-Sweet SF**® to form the diluent.
- 2. Crush tablets in a mortar to a fine powder.
- 3. Add the prepared diluent to form a smooth paste.
- 4. Gradually add the prepared diluent and transfer to the final measuring flask, rinsing the mortar well. Mix well.
- 5. Make up to final volume and mix well.
- 6. Label and package product appropriately.
