This helps keep antimicrobials working and improves patient care by facilitating:

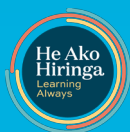
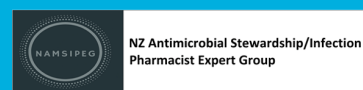
- Thoughtful prescribing
